In 2014 alone, Australian aid:

- Helped get **1.3 million** more children into school.
- Built more than 9,000 new classrooms.
- Trained over 100,000 teachers.
- Equipped more than 400,000 farmers with better technology.
- Vaccinated more than 2.3 million children.
- Supplied 2.9 million people with access to safe drinking water.
