
 It starts with a rural woman, with an exceptional spirit and a dream to make money for their family.

 Their business grows, so they can hire and train other artisans in their village. Through Wakami, they have a range of products they can make.


 The village is full of women making a stable income!

COFFEE HARVEST

Oxfam's Fairtrade organic coffee story begins on the hills around Maubisse, Timor-Leste. Coffee beans are grown and harvested by family farmers, the ripened red cherries are then sold to buyers from Café Timor Cooperative.



SOAKING AND HULLING

The coffee beans are taken by truck to the processing plant where the outer hulls are removed.













FERMENTING AND WASHING

The beans then go through fermentation and washing processes to remove mucilage and skin.







EXPORT TO AUSTRALIA Bagged beans are loaded into a

shipping container and taken to the

DRYING, GRADING
AND SORTING
The beans are dried on large tarpaulins in the sun for several weeks, before being separated by size and hand
