felt they gained additional practical tools which can be applied in their personal and professional lives.

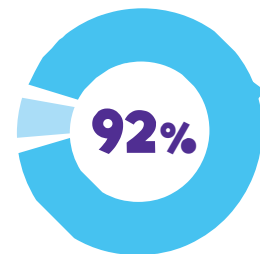
"I intend to do more research into what my local members stand for and ensure I am well informed for the next election."
