- We will help you as much as we can promptly, professionally and with integrity.
- Your right to privacy will be respected and Oxfam Australia will comply with the laws relating to use of personal data and fundraising.

- We will respond to all complaints in a serious and timely manner.
- All compliments and complaints are noted and reported to the Board on a quarterly basis.
